Books to Love

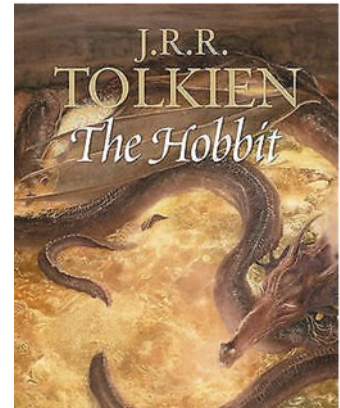
The Hobbit by J.R.R. Tolkien
