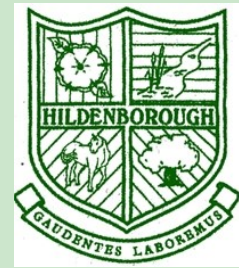

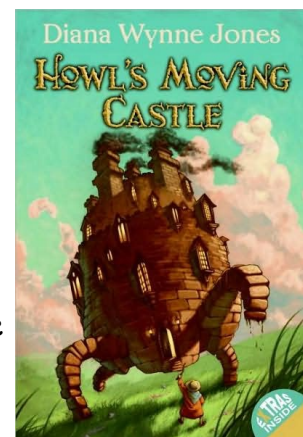


### Books to Love!

#### Howl's Moving Castle by Dianna Wynne Jones

I have always loved books about magic and one of my absolute favourites is Howl's Moving Castle. I first read it when I was at school and then rediscovered it as an adult. It is a book I have read again and again and, even though I know what is going to happen, I still find the story exciting, especially the final chapters, and I adore the ending. I also really love the way the world of the book is familiar, from the slightly old-fashioned clothing to the typically British locations and situations - it just happens to have magic!



The story starts when Sophie, the eldest of three and therefore destined to fail, is put under a curse by the Witch of the Waste. Determined to make the best of things, she decides to ask for help from the dreaded Wizard Howl who lives in a castle which drifts around the hills which surround the town. To untangle the curse, Sophie must handle the heartless Howl, strike a bargain with a fire demon, and meet the Witch of the Waste head-on. At its heart, this book is about Sophie's adventures while she tries to break the curse she is under and in doing so she discovers that not everyone, or everything, is what it seems.

A great read for anyone 9 and above who loves a magical quest!
